Human trafficking/sexual exploitation is an offence that involves controlling, forcing, intimidating, or deceiving a person of any age in order to exploit them into performing sexual acts or forced labour.

Preventing human trafficking is everyone's responsibility. Your observations and phone call can make all the difference in the world to someone who is being trafficked.

End Human Trafficking

Signs that someone may be a victim:

They may seem disoriented or disheveled.

They rarely, if ever, leave the premises or are escorted whenever they do.

They are traveling with little or no luggage.

They don't have identification or credit cards of their own.

They may claim to be visiting but aren't able to clarify where they're staying.

They appear withdrawn or intimidated and they rarely smile.

The person/people they're with seem to be preventing them from moving freely.
